Savo Ikon consists of two series, black and polished. Black series has black/grey details and black base. Polished series has black/polished details and polished aluminum base. Each series consists of five models. The first row shows Ikon1, 2 and 3 in black version and the second row shows Ikon3, 4 and 5 in polished version. All models can be delivered with armrests and head support.

Savo Maxikon – a bigger family member

Savo Maxikon has an extra high back rest giving a very comfortable sitting experience. It has the same unique advantages as the Savo Ikon, including the unique ergonomical sitting concept Savo Floating Tilt®.

Savo Ikon and Maxikon are easy to use. Even without any adjustments they are very comfortable. The chairs can be adjusted individually while sitting. The adjustments are simple and intuitive.

Savo Ikon and Maxikon are minimalism in practice. They do not have any unnecessary parts. You can mount or remove options quickly and easily without having to use any tools. Fewer parts mean a simpler and more environmental friendly production of the chairs. The main materials are plastic (polypropylen) and aluminum, both recyclable.



Variation, support and movement

To give possibility for variation and movement it is important with both individual adjustment and freedom to move. In a Savo chair you get freedom to move and a change between muscular activity and resting, depending on what you need. This can contribute to a reduced risk of muscular strain resulting in less sick leave. A flexible table height or a

stand up/sitting down solution will further reduce the risk, as a change between standing up and sitting down will increase the possibilities for the necessary movements. Savo Ikon and Maxikon complement a working table with flexible height.

Our motto: *Stand when you like – be in movement while sitting.*
